From fresh cuts of meat to homegrown fruits and vegetables, the shop offers a diverse selection of produce. They even have a farm shop cafe that serves breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea, featuring their own fresh ingredients. The shop and cafe are open seven days a week, so Attfield's makes it easy for locals to shop for and savour the best of Leicestershire.

2 Cini Restaurant & Hotel

Cini Restaurant in Enderby – which doubles as a hotel with eight bedrooms – offers a modern take on Italian cuisine, focusing on seasonal ingredients. The menu includes a range of options, from starters such as oven-baked mini calzone filled with ricotta to mains such as spaghetti with clams and pesto sauce. Meat lovers might want to opt for the likes of Pavé rump of beef served with rocket and skinny fries. For dessert, traditional choices like Tiramisù are available. 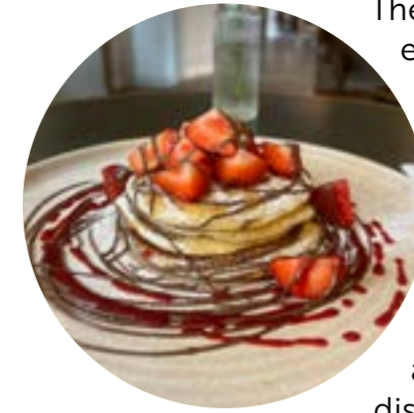
3 Dine India

Dine India in Countesthorpe has been serving a mix of modern and traditional Indian cuisine since 1999. It earned the title of Restaurant of the Year in the 2022 Leicester Curry Awards. With a seating capacity of 90 and its own parking facilities, the restaurant caters to both small and large groups. The eclectic decor merges Eastern and Western elements. The menu features intriguing dishes like Chicken Babri, a mild almond and lemon-infused dish, Chicken Kata Meta with a balance of hot, sweet, and sour flavours, and Achari Gosht, a lamb dish seasoned with pickled spices. 4 The Grey Gosling
22 Church Street, Thurlaston, LE9 7TA

The Grey Gosling in Thurlaston brings fresh energy to a village restaurant site with deep roots, serving modern British food with a focus on seasonality, flavour and well-sourced ingredients. Set in a building that has stood here since 1620, it gives new life to a well-known local landmark at the heart of the village. The menu moves from brunch and light lunches to stronger evening dishes and generous Sunday roasts, with options including aged steaks, pie of the day, fish and chips, pork belly and fishcake. Breakfasts are a strong draw too, with eggs Benedict, pancakes and full cooked plates. The Grey Gosling feels smart but relaxed, making it an excellent choice for anything from a casual bite to a proper meal out with friends. Service is warm and polished, and the varied menu means it works well for breakfast, lunch, dinner and relaxed weekend gatherings.

Croft Road, Cosby, LE9 1SG

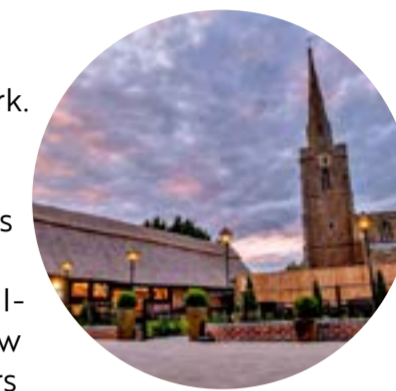

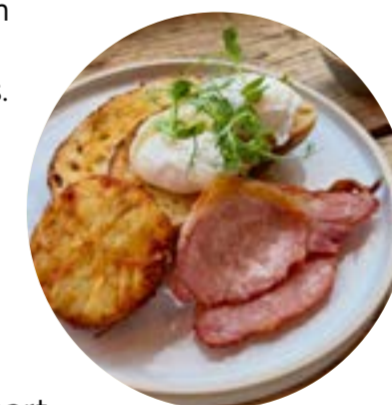
