

This park is in the historic area of Blaby and is the start of the Blaby Heritage Trail.

Under the turf you can see the medieval street plan of the original site of Blaby village. An original ice house can be found on site as well as a lake and Black Spinney. This is a good circular walk on a gravel path. There are picnic tables within the park and a small car park is available.

Distance: 0.5 miles/0.8 km/1,160 steps
